

About Entity Theatre e.V.



Entity Theatre e.V. has been delighting Munich theatre goers for 20 years. Founded as Entity Theatre Workshop in 1999, the organization has grown from a small group of drama enthusiasts into an award-winning English-language amateur performing group. It boasts over 100 members, who come from every corner of the globe. Entity Theatre e.V. became a registered society in 2008 and a member of the Verband Bayerischer Amateurtheater e.V. in 2014.

Entity usually stages three major productions a year, in spring, summer and winter. Our plays cover diverse genres from contemporary comedy and drama to Shakespeare and panto. Each show usually runs for eight to ten performances and relies on dedicated teams both on and off the stage. In addition, each autumn Entity organizes The 24-Hour Theatre Festival. Each participating group has only 24 hours to create, rehearse and stage a 10-minute sketch based on only a title and genre that have been given to them. The results are performed in front of a panel of judges who provide helpful criticism, as well as awarding prizes at the end of the night. The audience is entertained, amazed and often deeply moved by the wide variety of performances.

Entity also sponsors several workshops annually. They cover a wide variety of topics such as the basics of acting, character development, directing, lighting techniques and onstage combat. The workshops allow participants to explore theatre, work on team building, learn new skills and improve techniques. They are free and open to anyone over 18 who can speak English. Not a native speaker? No problem - only a minority of our members are native English speakers.

Entity participates regularly at FEATS (Festival of European Anglophone Theatrical Societies), where we have won numerous awards (please see Excellence Awards). This international competition of English-speaking amateur theatre groups draws groups from across mainland Europe. The festival is hosted in various European cities and will be coming to Munich for the first time this year.

Entity was founded in 1999 by Danny Strike and Alison Sandford. After the group explored theatre through a variety of workshops and rehearsals, Entity held its first performance in 2001. Entity remains committed to workshop principles – time to develop, experiment and have fun. We have now presented over 40 productions, and continue to learn, grow and enjoy entertaining Munich audiences.
