## 2 Getting to Wolf-Ferrari-Haus

### 2.1 Travel by public transport within Munich

Wolf-Ferrari-Haus is reachable via public transport.

For greater ease and convenience, we recommend installing the MVV-App:

<https://www.mvv-muenchen.de/en/journey-planer/mobile-services/mvv-app/index.html>.

This app will indicate the best routes and times to get from one place to another. You can also register for a mobile ticket which will allow you to purchase tickets via your smartphone,

Be sure to purchase a ticket from a ticket machine or from a bus driver BEFORE boarding any train/bus and to validate your ticket. Traveling without a valid ticket will incur a fine of 60€.

Depending on where you are coming from, you can take either the U-Bahn (underground) or S-Bahn (suburban train). From Munich city center (including the railway stations Hauptbahnhof and Ostbahnhof), you would need one of the following tickets:

- Single Ticket for 1 zone (Einzelfahrkarte 1 Zone) at 2,90€ for one person for a single trip in the direction of the destination. A return trip is not permitted.
- Stripe Ticket (Streifenkarte) at 14€ for 10 stripes would be more economical for additional trips on following days -- two stripes for 1 zone (Ottobrunn to City Center)
- Single Day Ticket inner circle (Single-Tageskarte Innenraum) at 6,70€ if only one person is travelling. This ticket allows you unlimited travel within the inner circle (white area) from the moment of ticket validation to 6am the following day. The cost is 16,80€ for 3 days.
- Group Day Ticket inner circle (Gruppen-Tageskarte Innenraum) at 12,80€ for 2-5 people travelling together. This ticket allows you unlimited travel within the inner circle (white area) from the moment of ticket validation to 6am the following day. The cost is 29,60€ for 3 days.

## 2.2 Travel by Air

If you are coming from Munich Airport, you would need to take the S-Bahn into town and the following ticket:

- Single Airport-City-Day-Ticket at 13,00€ for one passenger
- Airport-City-Day-Ticket-Gruppe at 24,30€ for 2-5 people travelling together.

Both tickets allow you unlimited travel within the entire MVV network from the moment of purchase to 6am the following day.

If you are not using a navigation system, please follow these instructions depending on where you are coming from:

- From city center via Mittlerer Ring B2R from northeast of Munich  
Follow B2R on Innsbrucker Ring and follow signs to A8 direction Rosenheim/Salzburg  
Turn left and follow the motorway  
Take exit 93 Unterhaching-Ost toward Unterhaching-Ost/Ottobrunn-Mitte  
After 700m turn right onto Ottobrunner Strasse (signs for Neubiberg/Ottobrunn-Mitte)  
After 200m turn right to stay on Ottobrunner Strasse  
After 1,4 km turn right onto Am Bogen
- From city center via Mittlerer Ring B2R from southwest of Munich  
Follow B2R on Chiemgaustrasse and follow signs to A8 direction Rosenheim/Salzburg  
Turn right and follow the motorway  
Take exit 93 Unterhaching-Ost toward Unterhaching-Ost/Ottobrunn-Mitte

After 700m turn right onto Ottobrunner Strasse (signs for Neubiberg/Ottobrunn-Mitte)

After 200m turn right to stay on Ottobrunner Strasse

After 1,4 km turn right onto Am Bogen

- From the south via motorway A8

Take exit 93 Unterhaching-Ost toward Unterhaching-Ost/Ottobrunn-Mitte

After 700m turn right onto Ottobrunner Strasse (signs for Neubiberg/Ottobrunn-Mitte)

After 200m turn right to stay on Ottobrunner Strasse

After 1,4 km turn right onto Am Bogen

- From the north via motorway A9/A99

Exit A9 at interchange Muenchen Nord to A99 direction Salzburg for about 25 km

Take exit 20 Ottobrunn toward Ottobrunn (Rosenheimer Landstrasse)

After about 3 km turn right onto Am Bogen

## 2.4 Taxis

Taxis tend to be quite expensive in Munich. But there is a taxi stand right outside of the theatre at [Rathausstrasse 1](#). From the main entrance, cross the square with the fountain and turn left.

## 2.5 Parking

There is a free underground car park below Wolf-Ferrari-Haus (entrance via Anton-Ripfel-Weg). Please do not use the slots for EDEKA but those for Wolf-Ferrari-Haus in the back. No cars are allowed in the underground car park from 3am to 6am. So you cannot leave your car there for the entire duration of the festival. Instead, we recommend parking at Unterhachinger Strasse or at Haidgraben. There are many unrestricted parking slots. From Haidgraben, it is about 2 km to the venue, which you can either walk or take bus 229 which passes Wolf-Ferrari-Haus (exit Rathausstrasse). Outside parking close to the venue (Am Bogen) is restricted to a maximum of 2 hours.

At Marienplatz, the heart and focal point of Munich, you can see the Glockenspiel (one of the world's most delightful clocks) which chimes every day at 11am, 12pm and 5pm, recounting an extravagant royal wedding, a jousting tournament, and the ritualistic dance of the coopers -- all events which have etched a mark on Munich's popular folklore. The show last about 15 minutes.

### 3.3 Ottobrunn

Ottobrunn is a municipality southeast of Munich that was founded in 1955. It is the European center of the aerospace industry and has achieved worldwide recognition as a center for high technology. It is also considered one of the most attractive business locations in Germany. The town's center was established in the mid 1980s, the town hall in 1983, and the community center Wolf-Ferrari-Haus in 1986.

#### **Fun Things to do in Ottobrunn**

- 1) There is a good range of recreational facilities through the Phönixbad with its extensive sauna and spa area, ice skating rink, sports stadium, and multi-purpose hall. Here one can also swim, sunbathe, and dine. The Phönixbad, Haidgraben 121, 85521 Ottobrunn, is open daily from 7:30am to 11pm; Thursdays from 8:30am to 11pm.
- 2) There is a room escape game called One Hour Left where you voluntarily lock yourself up with your team in a mysterious room with one clear goal in mind: to escape within 60

minutes. One Hour Left is located at Jaegerweg 10, 85521 Ottobrunn. For more info: [www.onehourleft.de](http://www.onehourleft.de).

## 4 Eating Out

Traditional Bavarian food is generally hearty, filling, and delicious, with many meat, poultry, fish, and potato-based dishes and *Knödels* (dumplings). There is a huge selection of some of the world's best sausages. Typical dishes include *Schweinebraten* (pork roast, with potato dumpling), *Leberkäse* (a kind of meatloaf), *Weisswurst* (white veal sausages served with sweet mustard). Some vegetarians options include *Sauerkraut*, *Knödels*, *Käsespätzle* (a type of pasta baked with cheese and onion). For the sweet tooth, there's *Apfelstrudel* (apple strudel), *Kaiserschmarrn* (a fluffy broken-up pancake), *Dampfnudeln* (sweet dumplings in custard). Because of international influences, there are restaurants catering to every taste, be it Italian, Japanese, Turkish, Vietnamese, Greek, Indian, Chinese, African, French, and so on.

If you want to eat outside of Ottobrunn, you can take bus 210 from Ottobrunn town center to Neuperlach Süd. From there, you can take the U5 to Munich city center or one stop to the shopping center PEP Neuperlach (at Neuperlach Zentrum). You could also walk to PEP from Neuperlach Süd in approximately 15 minutes. The PEP shopping center has several restaurants, bakeries, a supermarket, etc. Please note that PEP will not be open on Thursday May 30 and Sunday June 2.

# 5 Useful Information

## 5.1 Theatre information

The Wolf-Ferrari-Haus was opened in 1986 and is located in the centre of Ottobrunn, about 14 km southeast of Munich. It is designed as a multicultural centre and used for different activities like theatre, concerts, performances, musicals, comedies, or other events. There is a restaurant and beer garden on-site as well as other restaurants, cafés, supermarkets, banks, and a taxi stand nearby. The building is named after the very accomplished and prolific Italian composer Ermanno Wolf-Ferrari (1876-1948) who lived in Ottobrunn from 1915 to 1931. He is generally thought of as the finest writer of Italian comic opera of his time with such famous pieces as "Il segreto di Susanna." With the premiere of his cantata "La Vita Nuova" in Munich in 1903, the name Wolf-Ferrari attains international fame overnight.

## 5.2 Cash machines

The closest cash machine is at the *Sparkasse* inside the Rathaus at the Rathausplatz. There is another cash machine at the *HypoVereinsbank* at the corner of Rosenheimer Landstraße and Putzbrunner Straße. There are also cash machines at *Deutsche Bank* (Naupliaallee 2) and at *Volksbank Raiffeisenbank* (Rosenheimer Landstraße 69) in Ottobrunn.

There is also a doctor's office with doctors on call near the S-Bahn-station Ottobrunn at Karl-Stieler-Straße 6 (phone: 089 60019600 or without charge: 116117), where you can go on Saturday, Sunday, and bank holidays like on May 30th. If at Wolf-Ferrari-Haus, please inquire at the Hospitality Desk.

# 6 Hospitality

## 6.1 Hospitality Desk

The Hospitality Desk is located in Room 'Seminarraum E.232' (enter the building through the main entrance from the fountain and turn right and proceed to the end of the corridor) during the day and will be moved upstairs to the foyer of the theatre at 6pm. At our desk, you can ask our knowledgeable staff anything about FEATS or Ottobrunn or Munich.

The Hospitality Desk will be open from 10.00 – 21.45 (after second interval is over) each day. On Saturday June 1st Hospitality Desk will only be open from 12pm on.

## **7 Meet & Greet Room and Bar**

### **7.1 Meet and Greet**

Our Meet & Greet Room is located where the Hospitality Desk is -- Seminarraum E.232. The Meet & Greet Room is intended to provide a cosy space to have something to eat and drink, chat with friends, check your emails, or just chill out. There is free Wi-Fi throughout the building. We will provide drinks and small snacks on a cash donation basis.

The Meet & Greet Room will be open from 10:00 to 18:00 every day (except on Saturday June 1st, when it will be opened from 12:00 to 18:00). From 18.30 until the end of the performances, it will be only bar service upstairs in the foyer of the theatre.

### **7.2 Bar**

The bar will be open from 18.30 to midnight each day but will be closed during the actual performances.

## **8 Green Room**

As all dressing rooms are close to the stage, there is no Green Room. However, there will be water, tea, coffee and small snacks in the corridor in front of the dressing rooms for the participating groups of the FEATS main festival.

## **9 Wi-Fi**

There is free Wi-Fi available throughout the building.

## **10 Tickets**

Individual tickets for each night's performances, as well as the four-day festival pass, can be purchased online via Reservix at <https://wfh-ottobrunn.reservix.de>. As a participating actor or crew member, please obtain from your Stage Manager the code for the three-day pass for active participants. You can also get tickets at our Hospitality Desk during the festival subject to availability. Please either print out your ticket or download the Reservix app on your smartphone to show your ticket at the theatre door.

Concession tickets are available for full-time students (with a valid student card), seniors (age 65+), and disabled persons.



## 11 The FEATS Party

This year's FEATS Party will take place in the same building at the Ratssaal (where the Fringe will be taking place during the day) on Saturday June 1st, after the evening performances and adjudication, and will end at 02.00.

What? Food (bowl of Curry), late bar and dancing

When? Saturday June 1st from after evening performances/adjudication to 02.00

Price: free entrance, food for €15,00

Voucher for food can be picked up and paid for at the Hospitality Desk. However, for catering purposes, we do need to have a good idea of the number of food we have to prepare. ## 12 Fringe

The FEATS Fringe Festival offers a place for new groups to perform here for the first time as well as for established groups to offer a greater variety of performances that might not fit into the main festival. There is a wide variety of entertainment on offer, ranging from standard drama and comedy to Improvisation and workshops.

The best part is that there is no cost to see any of the performances and to participate in great workshops that might normally be offered at a significant cost. It is absolutely the best deal in Munich for the afternoons of Friday through Sunday (31 May - 2 June), 13:00–17:30 -- all of which will take place on the first floor of Wolf-Ferrari-Haus.

## 13 Adjudicator

The adjudicator for this year's festival will be Jan Palmer Sayer, B.Ed., MA, GoDA

We are delighted to welcome Jan back for her fourth FEATS. (She previously adjudicated for Bad Homburg in 2010, Antwerp in 2012, and Luxembourg in 2014.)

Jan trained at Middlesex University where she graduated with a degree in Drama and Education. She has worked in provincial theatre as an award-winning actor and director and was, for many years, head teacher of Hertswood, a specialist arts college.

She successfully combines a busy academic life with a stimulating theatrical one. In 1998, she was awarded an MA in Theatre and Performance Studies, at which time she was running her own highly inventive theatre company Shattered Windscreen. Her theatrical exploits have taken her as far afield as the Edinburgh Fringe Festival, as well as regular appearances at the famous cliff-side Minack Theatre in Cornwall.

Jan was appointed as a GoDA adjudicator in 2001. Her past festival experiences have included

Barnet, Cambridge, Felixstowe, Guernsey, Havering, Isle of Man, Sawston, Spelthorne & Runnymede, Thurrock, Wakefield, Waltham Forest, and the Woking Drama Festivals.
